

Early Capistrano Rancher Dies

SAN JUAN CAPISTRANO, March 29—Cornelio Echenique, 68, a resident of Orange County for 50 years and widely known as a rancher, owner of extensive properties and leading citizen of this area, died early today of a heart attack.

Death came at his San Clemente home, where he had lived scarcely a week since its completion by contractors who had been working on it for several months. In recent years he had lived at 2301 Fairmont Ave., Santa Ana. But his place of longer residence was his ranch home near here.

His widow Ysidora, who survives him, is a granddaughter of Don Juan Forster, head of the early San Juan Capistrano family, and a daughter of Don Marco Forster.

Mr. Echenique also leaves a sister, Isabel Echeverría of Reseda, and two brothers, Lucio of San Lucas and Rodriquo, who resides in Spain, where Cornelio Echenique was born.
